The CalCRN website hosts the **Career and College Readiness Lesson Plans** and has links to all CalCRN resources. See highlights on reverse side.

The **California CareerZone** is a career exploration system providing four easy-to-use career assessment tools. It connects users with information on more than 900 California occupational options and colleges across the country. The "Make Money Choices" budgeting tool helps students make the connection between future lifestyle choices and occupations that can financially support those choices. Free student account and educator account features. See highlights on reverse side.

The **California Career Center** is a comprehensive "virtual counselor" with career and college exploration and planning resources and tools to help students begin their career journeys. Free student account feature enables students to create and revise Career Action Plans, resumes, master job applications, and business letters. The Career Center also contains resources for counselors, teachers, parents, and guardians. Includes a Lesson Plan Creator for educators. See highlights on reverse side.

The **My Stuff Job Central** mobile app enables students to create and revise resumes, and master job applications, that can also be created and revised in their "My Stuff Job Central" student accounts. Download from your app store.

The **My Stuff CAP** mobile app enables students to create and revise Career Action Plans that can also be created and revised in their California Career Center website "My Stuff" accounts. Download from your app store.

The **Career Surfer** mobile app is a tool for beginning career exploration and planning. Students can take an interest quiz and then explore snapshots of the more than 900 occupations on their mobile devices. Text-to-speech enabled. Download from your app store.
